

- ▶ Started in 2017 Advanced Disability Management Services has been serving consumers in New Jersey by providing Support Coordination and Advocacy services for the past 5 years.
- Counties we serve are Bergen, Hudson, Passaic, Morris, Essex, Union, Middlesex, Monmouth, Somerset, and Ocean Counties.
- ▶ We currently serve over 350 consumers in 10 counties and still accepting new consumers in all 10 counties.



All of our support coordinators are highly knowledgeable with many years of experience, are educated with a minimum Bachelor Degree requirement and have obtained certification in person centered planning.




What we do at the Caring Community Center...

- We provide support coordination (case management) to adults 21+ with developmental/intellectual disabilities
- ✓ We are located in Essex County, but serve individuals in 8 counties through New Jersey – Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Middlesex, Morris, Passaic, Somerset and Union.
- ✓ We have support coordinators who are able to communicate in American Sign Language, English, and Spanish.
- ✓ We create detailed individualized service plans (ISP) specifically developed for your needs and interests. We approve our own plans which allows us to add, revise or remove services quickly without any delays.

We guide and support you in all areas of life!







Services

Community Connect

- We assess your wants, needs and interests to seek appropriate services for you in your community and link you to them
- Support coordinators will provide ongoing monitoring of your progress and achievements
- New services can be accessed at any time

Individualized budgeting

- We manage the specific annual budget you're given from the state of New Jersey
- We help you seek services that fit within your budget for the plan year
- We ensure that you utilize your budget to the fullest

Note: Your DDD budget will pay for most services that you are interested in.

Employment

- We connect you with job matching services to help you find successful and sustainable employment (DDD approved agencies, DVRS, etc.)
- We can match you with a compatible job coach to assist you on the job
- We can help you find employment that aligns with your interests



Services Continued

Home Care

- We guide you to hire family or friends to be paid caregivers
- We assist in finding experienced and professional in-home caregivers
- We analyze your budget to determine the exact amount of hours of care you are eligible for
- We will contact your insurance carrier to provide you with PPP/PCA services (additional care hours)

Social Roles

- We help you find opportunities in the community to develop valued and meaningful relationships
- We will connect you with local recreational outings (evenings/weekends), Day Program, Respite, Gym memberships, Classes (Art, Music, Swim, Horse back riding, etc.)
- Anything that you are interested in, let us know and we will find it for you!

Technology/Modifications

- We assist in finding an assistive technology item, piece of equipment, or product system, that is used to increase, maintain, or improve functional capabilities of participants.
- We coordinate adaptations to the private residence of the participant or the participant's family, based on assessment and as required by the participant's Service Plan, that are necessary to ensure the health, welfare and safety of the participant or that enable the participant to function with greater independence in the home.

Communication Emphasis: Team Approach in Supporting Person & Communicating (Individual, Guardian, Family, DSA Team, Providers, DDD and other entities)

 Strong Controls: Monthly SC & SCM & President reviews. Management Meetings biweekly. Online Accessible Information Platform for SC's and SCM's. Escalation Procedure for Concerns


