In each of these sessions, all ages and all disabilities will be considered for placement, with the requirement of all campers be vaccinated, which will limit campers to ages 16 and older. We will bunk the campers each session by under 18-year olds and by 18 and older adult age groupings (and of course will always separate all campers by gender). It may be possible we cannot accommodate 16 and 17-year olds in every session if there are not enough vaccinated campers at these ages to be able to fill a cabin for each session. The campers and counselors in each of our six cabins will travel to and participate in activities and meals together, keeping separated from other cabins to ensure limited exposure if for any reason we end up with a COVID positive case at the camp. This model of cabin "bubbling" is how most U.S. camps are handling daily activities and meals in summer 2021. We are building in now 2-3 full days in between sessions (compared to our past 1½ days between sessions) to allow for a more thorough cleaning of the entire camp. We will provide sliding-scale scholarships to all who apply and are eligible, which may allow those who usually attend our 5-day autism sessions to consider a 13-day session instead.
