



**EDUCATIONAL ENTERPRISES**  
**NEW AND UPDATED EDUCATIONAL SERVICES – 2022/2023**

- **INTERNSHIP EXPLORATION AND PLACEMENTS** – includes identifying appropriate internships sites that match the interest of the student (within his/her community) and required inspections and WBL state-mandated paperwork.
  - Job Developers can utilize NJCAN and additional tools to align student interests with pre-vocational goals.
  - Resume writing, interview skills, and monitoring student progress at internship site.
- **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TRANSITION PROGRAMS** – Including curriculum options, Development of TRANSITION PORTFOLIOS, Person-Centered Planning Practices, Career Exploration through Vocational Tours
- **TRANSITION ASSESSMENTS** – Vocational/Situational Assessments for students 16 years old and older. These are completed in natural work environments
- **BILINGUAL SPEECH EVALUATIONS** (Spanish)
- **DYSLEXIA COACHING and CURRICULUM SUPPORTS** - through LDTC– includes consultation with administrators, teachers, and ancillary staff
- **POST-SECONDARY GUIDANCE COUNSELOR**- Available to work with families and case managers in order to identify post-secondary options for students with disabilities. Exploration of college, trade schools, and specialized, post-high school programs. Counselor can also assist students and families as they navigate the college application process as well as where and how to find the right supports and modifications.
- **EXPANDED THERAPY SERVICES (OT, ST, PT)**
- **HOME INSTRUCTION** during the school day and after-school
