FDU EARLY COLLEGE DUAL ENROLLMENT

With FDU's Dual Enrollment Program, you can take credit-bearing FDU courses right at your own high school with other classmates. Courses are open to eligible students in grades 9 to 12.

- The college credits you earn can be applied toward your high school graduation requirements.
- They'll also be accepted toward an undergraduate degree at FDU and most other two- and four-year colleges and universities.
- Courses are taught by high school teachers at your school, using a college-level syllabus and other materials provided by FDU.



FDU EARLY COLLEGE ON CAMPUS

Our On-Campus Program allows you to join high school juniors and seniors, and visiting college students from other institutions.

- Classes are taught by FDU faculty and offered during the regular academic year.
- Choose from classes on FDU's Florham and Metropolitan campuses or online.
- Credits earned will be accepted toward an undergraduate degree at FDU and most other twoand four-year colleges and universities.



FDU EARLY COLLEGE SUMMER

Fairleigh Dickinson University's Early College Summer Program offers you the choice of engaging, interactive courses that tackle challenging topics and explore emerging career opportunities.

- Choose classes that are asynchronous online, in-person at FDU or remote with Zoom.
- Shortened 3- and 6-week class formats let you earn up to 9 or 12 college credits that can be applied toward an undergraduate degree at FDU and most other two- and four-year colleges and universities.
- Classmates include students from throughout New Jersey and beyond.
