Employer (Sponsor) Qualifications


Employers: Request USDOL application packet to register your business & sponsor an employee under "Contacts"

ELIGIBILITY TO REGISTER/SPONSOR

- Hold current license & NJ Tax ID
- Business address in New Jersey
- Sponsor FT/PT or 1099 worker with six months consecutive employment
- 1:1 Ratio of Sponsorship: Licensed Employer
Journeyman can act as sponsors
- Allow apprentices release time for RTI
- Report OJT hours in USDOL portal

FAQ

- Overtime payroll deduction counts toward OJT hours
- Transcripts from outside programs may support RTI credit
- Registered apprentices receive discounts in the Spring Semester if they completed a Fall Semester
- Certificate of Completion issued by USDOL after OJT/RTI completed
- Un-sponsored apprentices or unemployed students can enroll in classes and have hours retroactively credited
- Changes in employment status freezes OJT hours
- USDOL will accept up to 7,000 hours of previous verifiable OJT credit
- No time constraints exist to complete the required OJT/RTI hours
- NY tends to not reciprocate hours/credits
