

1:1 Ratio of Sponsorship: Licensed Employer Journeyman can act as sponsors

Allow apprentices release time for RTI

FAQ

- Overtime payroll deduction counts toward OJT hours
- Transcripts from outside programs may support RTI credit
- Registered apprentices receive discounts in the Spring Semester if they completed a Fall Semester
- Certificate of Completion issued by USDOL after OJT/RTI completed
- Unsponsored apprentices or unemployed students can enroll in classes and have hours retroactively credited
- Changes in employment status freezes OJT hours USDOL will accept up to 7,000 hours of previous verifiable OJT credit
- No time contraints exist to complete the required OJT/RTI hours


